**Text-to-speech** means you type the message out in English, Connect 5 will translate the text into the indicated language, *and be able to read it in a computerized voice in that language*. After translating, your message can be sent without further adjustment.

NOTE: Items marked with an \* in the list above indicate that the language is a double-byte language and may require additional language packs installed on your Operating System.
